Introduction

In the summer of 2005, www.mastercomposter.com conducted a survey to determine what composters know about the effect of compost on soil, and how certain they are of their knowledge.

The following instructions headed the survey:

The following claims have been made by at least one person regarding the benefits of compost. That person may have been a snake-oil salesman. That person may have been a knowledgeable resource. Do you believe each statement is a myth or a fact?

Respondents were shown 8 statements about compost and asked to give one of four answers to reflect their belief about the given statement:




- a. I believe it works and I can EXPLAIN how it works.
- b. I believe it but CANNOT explain how it works.
- c. I don't believe it.
- d. I'm not sure.

The ninth question further tested the certainty of composters' knowledge by asking "Out of 8 questions, how many are you certain you got right?"

Responses to all questions are given in this report.

Survey Statement #1: Compost improves drainage if your soil has a drainage problem. But it also improves water retention if your soil drains too quickly.





Survey Statement #2: Compost makes water more available to plant roots, i.e., soil water is more easily taken up by them.






Survey Statement #7: Compost binds heavy metals in soil so that they do not contaminate water resources, plants, nor humans.
